Barangay Bel-Air constituents have much to rejoice. They will enjoy once more the comfort of riding the e-jeepneys, free of charge, courtesy of Barangay Bel-Air which recently bought 2 units of e-jeepneys..

Bel-Air Seniors will be transported in going to the malls such as Power Plant and Glorietta located around the village. During the conduct of KST, the Kasambahays will be fetched by these e-jeepneys.

The e-jeepneys were first introduced in Bel-Air Village last year to promote the use of environment friendly, pollution-free public transportation. The test run was part of the city government's drive for cleaner air.

The electronic jeepney is a prototype vehicle powered by rechargeable batteries and organic waste and is designed to avert the use of fossil fuel and help mitigate climate change as it addresses problems on air pollution and solid waste.
