### OUTGOING BEL-AIR PRESIDENT ROBERTO C. BENARES PASSES ON THE HELM TO INCOMING PRESIDENT LEANDRO G. SANTILLAN

During the organizational meeting of the Board of Governors on July 8, 2009, outgoing President, Mr. Roberto C. Benares officially handed over the helm of Bel-Air Village Association, Inc. ("BAVA") to Mr. Leandro G. Santillan as the Association's new President.

Mr. Benares remains to be part of the Board as *Ex-Officio Governor* with Mrs. Constanca Lichauco & Atty. Teodoro Regala as BAVA's Consultants.

Governor Bautista holds a Master's Degree in Business Management, Governor de Guzman is a Chemical Engineering Graduate while Governor Reyes, the lone female Governor, graduated with B.S.
